Total Knee Replacement . . . or Not? AOSMI Orthopedic Surgeon Presented Latest Information at Free Seminar

AOSMI's Dr. Banzon provided information about computer-aided knee replacement and its advantages, such as smaller incisions, faster recovery, less bleeding, less pain, and increased implant longevity.
