With specialty training in trauma, Dr. Gallacher provides trauma care for adult fractures, including reconstruction and replacement of complex shoulder and elbow fractures. She strives to provide a comprehensive approach to recovery including both non-surgical and surgical techniques to minimize pain and restore function.

As a former division one collegiate athlete, who continues to maintain an active, athletic lifestyle, Dr. Gallacher understands the unique needs of athletes and active individuals. She works closely with other specialties and services such as physical therapy to maximize recovery and return to activities.
